#### **Multiskills Festival**

We have had a fantastic last week of November and have officially welcomed in December and the start of the Christmas chaos! On Tuesday we were joined by all the Year 1 & 2 children from across the Trust, who came to Lapford to take part in a multiskills festival, expertly led by Miss Sloman and Mrs James from Primary Sports. The event saw the children participating in twelve different activity stations where they worked alongside their peers from our Trust schools to really develop their teamwork and gross motor skills. All the children involved reported what a great time they had, and members of staff commented on how well our children engaged - giving their all to every activity and supporting their peers enthusiastically. Well done Skylarks!

#### Staff ASD training

Each academic year, staff are provided with in depth training on a specific area of SEND. This year our focus is on Autism and after school on Tuesday, staff attended their second training session on supporting children with autism in the primary classroom. This was delivered by Laura Matthews, advisory teacher from the Devon Education Services Autism team and was exceptionally interesting and useful. As well as helping staff understand more about autism and the challenges that autistic children face, she also armed us with a wealth of strategies and toolkits to use with our ASD children.

#### **Music Lessons**



On Thursday we were lucky enough to be serenaded by Jemma Bloch and Mr Pooley. Jemma is a local flute teacher who we are welcoming to school to offer peripatetic music lessons to any interested children. She gave us a short introduction to the flute, demonstrating the instrument and also showing the children the Kinder Flute and Fife. Mr Pooley is also offering instrumental lessons and wowed us with his



demonstrations of Spanish, Acoustic and Electric guitars. It was a real treat to hear live music in our school and many children took away letters about lessons. If your child is interested and has not brought home a letter, please collect a copy from the office.

#### **Nativity Time!**

This week, we are looking forward to both the EYFS and KS1 Nativities. Both are taking place on Wednesday, with Robins at 2:30pm and Skylarks after school at 6:00pm.
